 **Talk:** Read Genesis 1:1-2:3

1. How did God create everything in these verses? What did He use? How does this compare to how we as humans create things?
2. Which day of creation is your favorite? Why?
3. Look at the parts of creation in this passage. What does God provide for mankind in each part? For example in verses 3-5 God creates the day and night cycle in which we live. In verses 6-8 he gives us the air we breathe.
4. What command does God give in verse 22? To which part of creation does he give it? What other part of creation does he give this command to in the passage?
5. How is mankind different from the rest of God's creation? In what image does He make man? What does He tell mankind to have over the rest of creation?
6. How is the seventh day different from the other days of creation? Why is it called holy?
7. What distinctions (or separations) do you see God making as he creates? Which distinctions has our world rebelled against the most?
8. Where do you see or hear evidence of God's creation right now?

 **Pray:** Dear God, we see Your power and beauty displayed everywhere as we see Your handiwork in creation. Thank You for giving us life and providing for our needs. Lord, help us to walk in humility and submission to Your authority and help us to worship You as You designed. Thank You for giving us Your Son so that through faith in Him we might have eternal life!
