 **Walk:** Find a local little library (littlefreelibrary.org/map) and donate a Bible or Gospel-centered book to help spread some Gospel seed in your own neighborhood.

 **Talk:** Read Mark 4:26-29

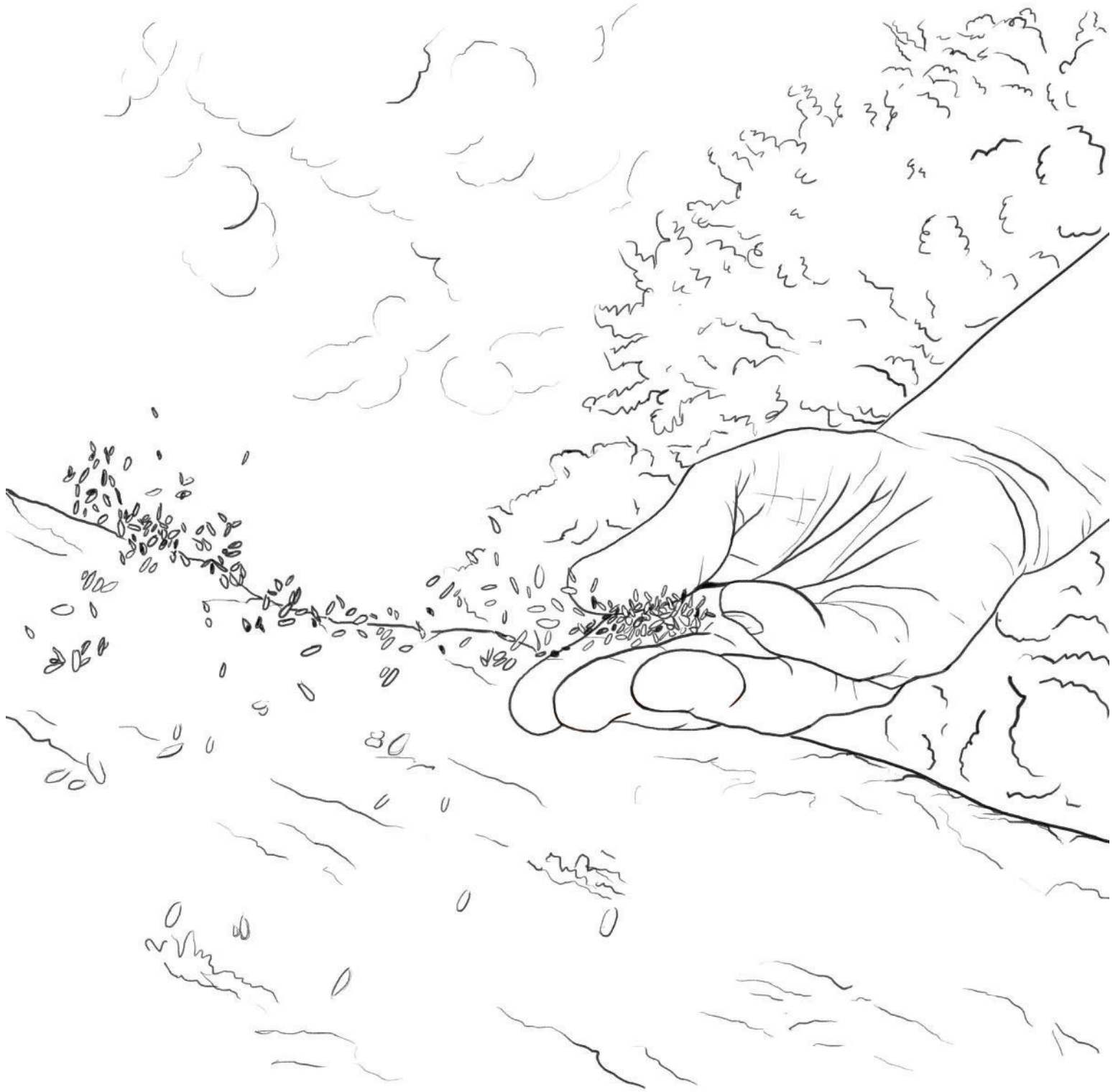
1. Jesus often taught using parables, simple stories that help illustrate a spiritual truth. Looking at verse 26, what does He say this parable is meant to show?
2. Earlier in this same chapter, Jesus shares another parable about sowing seed. Looking back at verse 14 to see what he says the seed represents?
3. In this parable how does the man sow the seed? Look at the picture and try mimicking his action. Do you think that sowing this way would require a few or many seeds?
4. What are some ways that God's Word is being sown in you and your family? Beside the library donation, what are some others ways that your family and your church can be sowing Gospel seeds?
5. In the parable what details remind us that the growth of the seed takes time and is a gradual process? How might this give your family patience and confidence in God's work in your own lives and in others?
6. What does the sower do when the seed has fully formed into a mature plant with grain in it? Take time to share a testimony or two of how members of your family came to faith in Christ. Who were some of the people God used in that process to sow seeds and to help bring the harvest?

 **Pray:** Dear God. We thank you for your Word and your Holy Spirit that have worked in our family to bring ones to faith in You. Lord, help us continue to grow in our faith and to actively spread the good news of the Gospel so that others in our family and community might know the joy of salvation. We pray that You might even use this library donation to help someone to learn of the Gospel. Help us sow your Word abundantly and please bring the harvest. Amen!
